

Fall ATV/UTV Safety

HUNTING ATV/UTV SAFETY TIPS

- Firearms must be unloaded when in any type of vehicle.
- You cannot have or transport a cocked crossbow in a motorized vehicle unless the bolt is removed.
- It is illegal to load a firearm while it is in a motorized vehicle
- You cannot discharge any firearm in or from any moving or stationary motorized vehicle, except for certain disabled hunters with proper permits.
- Qualified disabled hunters with a permit authorizing them to shoot from a stationary vehicle must have all firearms unloaded while the motorized vehicle is in motion.
- It is illegal in Wisconsin to drive after, pursue, or harass any wild animal in any motorized vehicle.
